NOTICE! This is just a very shortened checklist which contains a few requirements that are mandatory to comply with most directives. Please be aware that some directives, like the Machinery Directive, have dozens of requirements on the instructions.

We will send you more information about this shortly!

How to check quickly if the mandatory requirements have been taken into account:

- Do the instructions contain all safety information on how to prevent any risks related to the use of the product?
- Is the manual translated into a language spoken in the country where the product is placed on the market?
- Does the manual contain the CE mark?
- Does the manual contain information on the intended use of the product?
- Does the manual contain the company name, registered trade name or registered trade mark and the postal address (if not provided on the product itself or its packaging)?
- Does the manual contain a type, batch or serial number or other element allowing its identification (if not provided on the product itself or its packaging)?
- Are the manual and/or the safety instructions provided with the product in the packaging?
- Is the meaning of the WEEE symbol explained in the manual (in case of electronic products only)?
